Chabad offers a wide range of opportunities both religious and social. We stress the importance of Jewish education, but more importantly, we offer the opportunity to experience first-hand, the vitality and relevance of Torah True Judaism as it is lived today. Participants in our programmes, classes & activities experience the joy and celebration, the intimacy and compassion, the wisdom and knowledge that is inherent in Jewish life and learning.

Chabad is a full service – based organisation responding to both the material and spiritual needs of the whole community in Ilford, Buckhurst Hill, Epping, Southend and its surrounding areas throughout Essex. Through our warm, welcoming and inclusive services, classes, celebrations, holiday events and youth programmes, Chabad will use whatever means necessary to bring the message of our rich heritage to the children, teens, adults and older members in the community.

Our Centre is part of a network of thousands of Chabad Centres which span the globe. In 2005 we set up a branch in Buckhurst Hill to service the wider West Essex area which is directed by Rabbi Odom Brandman and his wife Henny. In the summer of 2018 we leased a small house in Epping as its first Chabad house. These successful centres were set up responding to the change in demographics in the wider community. We plan to map watch and continue building Chabad Centres throughout rural Essex and N.E. London.

Our Centres are entirely financially independent. We receive no grants from New York nor Stamford Hill. Our total budget has to be raised locally and we depend on our friends and supporters to help. This guide is an outline of our contribution to this Community and also offers you ways to become our partners and help us maintain and develop our services. Feel free to stop by one of our Centres at any time to participate in any of our multitude of ongoing programmes.

The Lubavitcher Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem M. Schneerson zy"o, would often urge us not to be satisfied with our previous achievements. CHABAD - SERVICING OUR LOCAL COMMUNITY

CHABAD LUBAVITCH CENTRE GANTS HILL, ILFORD

Our regional Head Office in Gants Hill has been serving the local Jewish community for over 35 years. In addition to its offices the Centre houses a Synagogue, Judaica Shop, Bar/Bat Mitzvah Club, Teenage Girls and Boys activities, lending library. The Chabad house is a daily hub of activity. Holiday programmes, counselling services dealing with addiction issues and general wellbeing

CHABAD LUBAVITCH CENTRE BUCKHURST HILL

Our centre in Buckhurst Hill was established in 2005 in response to the increasing migration of Jewish people to the West Essex regions of Buckhurst Hill and beyond. We already have a warm and welcoming Synagogue and many youth and adult services where every Jew is welcomed and made to feel comfortable. We have developed a community centre which is open to all, offering a wide range of programmes with something to suit everyone.

CHABAD LUBAVITCH CENTRE EPPING

Chabad activities have been ongoing since its first activities were held there in 2016. In June 2018, we leased a small house as the Centre of Chabad Epping activities. Services include monthly Shabbat services, monthly discussion groups, holiday programmes and children's club.

HEBREW SCHOOL - SUNDAY CHEDER - GANTS HILL, ILFORD

Chabad has a lively interactive Hebrew School on Sunday mornings based at our Gants Hill Centre. The classes offer a stimulating yet friendly environment where children embrace their Jewish roots and gain a true sense of Jewish pride, no matter their level of observance or affiliation. Children, ages 5-12 acquire a broad knowledge of Judaism through a motivating and challenging curriculum. Our goal is simple: We want our students to view Judaism in an intelligent, relevant and upbeat light. We offer a special course as Bar/Bat mitzvah preparation as a part of the Cheder and can arrange private tuition for boys and girls to prepare for their ceremonies.

LEARNING FOR ALL

Chabad offers a full range of learning opportunities for men and women. From group sessions to one on one, the level of learning is from beginners through to advanced subjects. There is a rich learning opportunity for each and every one who desires to improve their Jewish knowledge. Our new Centre is modern and Hi-tech often used as a part of the interactive learning and discussion groups on offer.

GAN YISROEL - SUMMER & WINTER DAY & OVERNIGHT CAMPS

Our holiday schemes have earned a great reputation as a trendsetter for many Summer and Winter Camps. As part of the largest & fastest growing network of Jewish day camps in the world, campers enjoy a range of innovative activities, sports, games, trips & more in a warm and caring environment.

Over the summer holiday we have various divisions catering for nursery children, primary school ages and teenage boys and girls programmes. A Winter Day Camp and a boys Winter Skiing trip with weekends away for girls are among the highlights of the year for many children.

SOCIAL SERVICES

Rabbi Sufrin MBE (CASAP) is a licensed qualified Addiction Counsellor and Consultant on matters related to addictions. Mrs Sufrin is a qualified Counsellor (BACP Registered) and sees clients on a one to one basis on a wide range of issues. Rabbi Sufrin MBE oversees various group and drop in sessions, supporting those affected by addictions as well as seeing those who need support on a one on one basis.

OUR SYNAGOGUE

The Shul (Synagogue) at Chabad, is one of the many important facets of the activities and services operated from our Chabad Lubavitch Centres based in Gants Hill, under the direction of Rabbi Aryeh Sufrin MBE and at Buckhurst Hill, Essex, led by Rabbi Odom Brandman.

Just by walking through the front doors, and being warmly greeted initially by one of the shul members, (as a security volunteer), you will already feel and hear the special atmosphere within.

The friendly greetings and welcome given to all who attend, from the first visit thereafter, helps everyone relax and become a part of the "family of Chabad" within North East London & Essex.

There is no need to worry or to be uncomfortable if you or your fellow guests feel that Hebrew reading and knowledge is not yet at the level that you may expect it to be – Chabad's philosophy is to greet all with open arms and assist you along your Shabbat morning shul experience.

The prayers and reading from the Torah are made easy to follow as they are helped along by explanations, both written and verbal in English and pages are announced throughout.

Under the direction of Mrs Devorah Sufrin, younger children have Play and Pray Programmes every week. Firstly children sit with parents in the shul environment followed at 11am by a Children's service, under trained youth educators, where there is basic Davening followed by their own Kiddush as well as activities and games. Recently added into the mix is a discussion group for teenagers led by one of our Shluchos which runs parallel to our children's service.

At some point in the future you may even wish to access weekly learning opportunities for men and women to understand our prayers better and develop your own knowledge, as it is never too late to learn – which is the philosophy of Chabad.

Midway through the Shabbat morning service "timespeak" is presented by one of the regular members, giving the community an opportunity to participate in sharing the basic story and lessons from the Sedra (Torah Reading) before it is read.

The weekly Drosha (sermon) delivered by Rabbi Aryeh Sufrin, always gives over a deeper message, about how the Sedra is applicable to our everyday lives while retaining the interest of all with his unique all-encompassing warmth and humorous style.

Every week the service concludes with a hot cholent (vegetarian) Kiddush, with sweet and savoury delicacies and "lechaim" and of course non-alcoholic drinks. Notwithstanding that Chabad is renowned for its selection of Malt whiskies and Vodka, whilst responsible drinking is taken seriously and practiced by all at Chabad. It is undoubtedly the best time for all to socialise and catch up with the other members of the Chabad family and develop and strengthen friendships.

Specially catered events eg Shabbat Lunches, Friday Night Dinners take place throughout the year, comprising all the traditional foods together with singing and socialising whilst listening to words of wisdom and encouragement. We also arrange hospitality and meals for guests visiting the area for Shabbat, as well as when asked to support the elderly and sick.

If you or someone you know would like to try the Chabad Shabbat experience, this is an open invitation to take that initial step through the doors of 397 Eastern Avenue.

MEMBERSHIP DETAILS

At Chabad, every Jew is always welcomed and we never turn anybody away from any of our programmes or events. Our Synagogue is open to all whether you are affiliated to any other synagogue or organization.
